



Summary of Rainy Lake Medical Center's Financial Assistance Policy Plain Language Summary

Rainy Lake Medical Center's financial assistance program (Community Care program and Sliding Fee scale discount) provides free or reduced cost healthcare to patients who are unable to pay fully for services received at our facility dependent on income guidelines.

Coverage

Services covered are those that are medically necessary and provided to you by Rainy Lake Medical Center's staff and billed by Rainy Lake Medical Center. Services that would not be covered are cosmetic or elective procedures and services provided by outreach providers that would bill separately such as radiologists and cardiologists.

Eligibility

Eligibility is based on your income and your application for, and use of, any private or government healthcare coverage available to you.

Once criteria are met, our program may assist you with unpaid bills, including those resulting from insurance deductibles and co-payments.

Financial Assistance eligibility is divided into three categories based on income;

1. Any person who qualifies under the guidelines and whose income is at or below 200% of the Federal poverty level (updated annually), adjusted for family size is entitled to care at no cost.
2. Any person whose income is more than 200% but not more than 300% of the Federal poverty level (updated annually), adjusted for family size is entitled to a reduced cost based on the sliding fee scale established by the Rainy Lake Medical Center and approved by the Board of Trustees.
3. Any person whose income exceeds 300% of the Federal poverty level (updated annually), adjusted for family size may be eligible for reduced cost if their income is not sufficient to enable them to fully pay for the services. It is the determination of the Rainy Lake Medical Center to reduce charges.

Obtaining an Application

Once eligibility is determined, an uninsured patient's charges will not exceed those that are the average generally billed to patients with insurance coverage.
